

Orientation

Entering daycare is a significant moment in the lives of children and their families. At our FRÖBEL Daumstrasse facility, our educational professionals pay special attention to this moment by individualizing the orientation process.

Our guide and framework is the Munich orientation model.

An approach that includes the child and addresses their individual needs is important to us, which is why the orientation, after the initial phase and in consultation with us, can be based on the Berlin orientation model. The time frame can be between four and six weeks and vary individually.

In principle, we give your child sufficient time during the orientation phase to familiarize themselves with the new environment, their educators, the children, and our routines. During this time, you as parents will have the opportunity to get to know our facility and its structures, and will also come to know our educators as competent and informative advisors. You will thus know your child to be in reliable hands.

Orientation is complete when your child feels safe and comfortable in their new environment and has come to trust their new caregivers.
